The Foundation will offer two types of grant applications, Mini-Grants, and Grants. The Foundation will accept Mini-Grant proposals throughout the year and Grant proposals in the spring.

Mini-Grants should be proposals of \$500 or less in total. The application for a Mini-Grant consists of a written application and a FlipGrid video.
